Typically, with duty and freight, the owner had paid twice as much to get his Bertram as you would pay. Typically, he didn't regret it. And, typically,

his next boat will be a Bertram, too. Specifically, our 40⁺ Yacht.

That's the way it's been since the first Bertrams appeared nearly 20 years ago. You spend some time at sea in one, and every other boat pales. You get your own, and the only choice after is a bigger Bertram.
